THE BRITISH GUIANA (CONSTITUTION) ORDER IN COUNCIL, 1961.

WHEREAS it is provided by subsection (1) of section 6 of the British Guiana (Constitution) Order in Council, 1961, that until the Governor, with the concurrence of a Secretary of State, declares by order published in the Gazette that the said section 6 shall cease to have effect, the Constitution of British Guiana shall have effect as if there were inserted therein certain provisions specified in the said section and relating to public safety and public order:

NOW THEREFORE, in pursuance of the provisions of the said subsection and with the concurrence of a Secretary of State, I do hereby declare that section 6 of the British Guiana (Constitution) Order in Council, 1961, shall cease to have effect.
