ORDER

MADE UNDER

THE INCOME TAX (IN AID OF INDUSTRY) ORDINANCE,  
(Chapter 300).

UNDER SECTION 1(2) OF THE INCOME TAX (IN AID OF INDUSTRY) ORDINANCE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH PARAGRAPH 1 OF ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Income Tax (In Aid of Industry) Order, 1961.

2. Item 4 of the first schedule to the Income Tax (In Aid of Industry) Ordinance\*, is hereby amended by the substitution of a comma for the full stop after the word "metal" at the end of the item and the insertion thereafter of the words "and clothing."
