**ORDER**

**THE CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICES (REMUNERATION OF HOLDERS) ACT  
(Cap. 27:11)**

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 3 OF THE CONSTITUTION OFFICES (REMUNERATION OF HOLDERS) ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:—

1. This Order, which amends the Constitutional Offices (Holders' Allowances) Order, may be cited as the Constitutional Offices (Holders' Allowances) (Amendment) Order 1981 and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 14th November, 1980.

2. The Principal Order is hereby amended by the addition of the following clause after clause 10 —

“11. In addition to the emoluments and allowances otherwise payable to him, there shall be paid to the Temporary Chairman of the Elections Commission for such time as that office is held by Cde. H. B. S. Bollers

(a) a duty allowance of 3,600 per annum;

(b) a house allowance of 3,600 per annum, and

(c) an allowance to be paid by him as a gratuity to his chauffeur calculated at the rate of twenty-two and one half per cent of the basic salary (as determined by the Minister) paid to the chauffeur for each completed month of employment, payable either at intervals of six months or at the termination of the employment of the chauffeur, except that no such allowance shall be paid unless he certifies that the chauffeur has discharged his duties satisfactorily.”
