THE VALUATION FOR RATING PURPOSES ACT

(Cap. 28:04)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 4 OF THE VALUATION FOR RATING PURPOSES ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Valuation for Rating Purposes (Preparation of Valuation List) (John/Port Mourant Village District) Order 1981.
2. The Chief Valuation Officer is hereby directed to prepare a valuation list for the area described in the Schedule.
3. The day on which the Chief Valuation Officer shall commence the preparation of the valuation list shall be 1st April, 1981, and the date at which all property in the aforesaid area shall be valued shall be 1st April, 1981.

SCHEDULE

BOUNDARIES OF JOHN/PORT MOURANT VILLAGE DISTRICT

That area comprising the first, second, third and fourth depths of the estates from Port Mourant to Haswell and the first, second and third depths of the estates from Resource to John, being a portion of Region No. 6 or the East Berbice/ Corentyne Region and bounded as follow :—

- On the North By mean Low Water Mark of the Atlantic Ocean from its intersection with the Northern prolongation of the common boundary between the estates known as Port Mourant and Rose Hall to its intersection with the Northern prolongation of the common boundary between the estate known as John and Bloomfield.
- On the South By the Northern edge of the drainage trench immediately north of Harmony Dam from its intersection with the Southern prolongation of the common boundary between the estates known as John and Bloomfield to its intersection with the Southern prolongation of the common boundary between the estates known as Port Mourant and Rose Hall.
- On the East By the common boundary between the estate known as John and Bloomfield and its northern and southern prolongation from its intersection with mean Low Water Mark of the Atlantic Ocean to its intersection with the Northern edge of the drainage trench immediately North of Harmony Dam.
- On the West By the common boundary between the estates known as Port Mourant and Rose Hall and its Southern and Northern prolongations from its intersection with the Northern edge of the drainage trench immediately North of Harmony Dam to its intersection with mean Low Water Mark of the Atlantic Ocean.
