IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 9A OF THE LABOUR ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:—

1. This Order, which amends the Minimum Wages (Cinema Employees) Order\*, may be cited as the Minimum Wages (Cinema Employees) (Amendment) Order 1981, and shall come into operation on 7th December, 1981.

2. The Principal Order is hereby amended in the following manner —

- (a) by the deletion in clause 2 of the definitions of “Group A Cinema” and “Group B Cinema”;
- (b) by the deletion in clause 3(1) of the words “or third” and “as the case may be”;
- (c) by the deletion of clause 6;
- (d) by the substitution for the Schedule of the following:—

<b>Operators</b>	\$90.00 per week
<b>General Staff —</b>	
Under 18 years	\$54.00 per week
18 years old and over	\$69.52 per week
<b>Cashiers</b>	\$69.52 per week
<b>Clerical Assistants</b>	\$69.52 per week
<b>Ticket Collectors</b>	\$69.52 per week
<b>Guards</b>	\$69.52 per week
<b>Sweepers/Cleaners</b>	\$54.00 per week

The minimum rates of wages payable to a person employed during any period of time mentioned in this Schedule in more than one category of work set out above in respect of which different minimum rates of wages are set out, shall be the highest of such rates.

The minimum rate of wages payable to a person employed in any of the above categories of work for any shorter period of time than the appropriate period set out above shall be the appropriate minimum rate are set out, shall be the highest of such rates.
