THE ACQUISITION OF LANDS FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES ACT

(Chapter 62:05)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTIONS 3 AND 4 OF THE ACQUISITION OF LANDS FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Acquisition of Lands for Public Purposes (Construction of President's College) Order 1985.

2. The proposed construction of the President's College on the lands described in the Schedule hereto is hereby declared to be a public work.

3. The Chief Works Officer, together with his agents, servants or workmen, is hereby authorised to enter upon the said lands for the purpose of surveying or otherwise examining such lands with a view to the acquisition of the whole or part of such lands for the public work aforesaid.

SCHEDULE

Lots numbered 16 to 26, being parts of the east and west halves of Section 'D' together with lots 1 to 52, being parts of the east and west halves of Section 'E', lying in a portion of Golden Grove Village situate on the east sea coast of the County of Demerara containing an area of (150) one hundred and fifty acres, the said Golden Grove Village being shown on a plan by A. J. Alcorn, Sworn Land Surveyor, dated 28th November, 1873, on record in the Department of Lands and Surveys as plan No. 4763. The said lots in the said Golden Grove Village are bounded as follows:—

ON THE NORTH — By the common boundary of lots 15 and 16 Section 'D' Golden Grove Village.

ON THE EAST — By the side line dam between Golden Grove Village and Plantation Nabaclis.

ON THE SOUTH — By the southern boundary of lot 52 Section 'E' Golden Grove Village.

ON THE WEST — By the side line dam between Golden Grove Village and Plantation Haslington.
