THE CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICES (REMUNERATION OF
HOLDERS) ACT

(Cap. 27:11)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTIONS
3 AND 6 OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICES (REMUNERA-
TION OF HOLDERS) ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING
ORDER :—

1. This Order, which amends the Constitutional Offices ^{Citation and} (Holders' Allowances) Order*, may be cited as the Constitutional ^{commence-} Offices (Holders' Allowances) (Amendment) Order 1985 and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1st January, 1984.

2. Clause 4 of the Principal Order is hereby amended by ^{Amendment} the substitution for the words "~~8,400~~" "^{of clause 4} "\$7,200" in both places ^{of the Princi-} where they occur, "\$6,000" and ", 00" of the words "\$10,800", ^{pal Order.} "\$9,600", "\$8,400" and "\$7,200" respectively.

3. Clause 5(1) of the Principal Order is hereby amended ^{Amendment} by the substitution for the words beginning with "the Chancellor" ^{of clause 5} and ending with "other judge" of the words "every judge" and ^{of the Princi-} for the words "\$332" and "\$377" of the words "\$720" and "\$810" ^{pal Order.} respectively.

4. Clause 6 of the Principal Order is hereby amended by ^{Amendment} the substitution for paragraph (1) of the following paragraph — ^{of clause 6} ^{of the Princi-} ^{pal Order.}

*Cap. 27:11 Subsidiary Legislation.

"(1) In respect of the use of his motor car on official
duty there shall be paid —

- (a) to every judge of the Supreme Court, the Ombudsman, the Director of Public Prosecutions and the Auditor General a travelling allowance consisting of a fixed allowance of \$700 per month and a mileage allowance payable under the Scale A rate applicable to public officers from time to time; and
- (b) to the Chairman of the Elections Commission, the Commissioner of Police and every member of a Service Commission (not being a judge of the Supreme Court) a travelling allowance at the Scale C rate applicable to public officers from time to time, "

such travelling allowance being payable subject to the conditions of payment of travelling allowance from time to time applying to officers in the public service."

Amendment of clause 7 of the Principal Order. 5. Clause 7(1) of the Principal Order is hereby amended by the substitution for the word "fifty" of the words "one hundred"

Amendment of clause 8 of the Principal Order. 6. Clause 8 of the Principal Order is hereby amended by the substitution for the words "\$500" in both places where they occur, "\$400" and "\$300" of the words "\$300", "\$500" and "\$400" respectively.

Amendment of clause 10 of the Principal Order. 7. Clause 10 of the Principal Order is hereby amended by the substitution for the words "six hundred", "five hundred" in both places where they occur, and "four hundred" of the words "one thousand", "seven hundred" and "six hundred" respectively.

Amendment of clause 11 of the Principal Order. 8. Clause 11 of the Principal Order is hereby amended as follows —

- (a) in paragraph (i) and (vi), by the substitution for the words "\$4,800" of the words "\$7,200";
- (b) in paragraph (v), by the substitution for the words "\$3,600" of the words "\$4,800".
