HOLDERS) ACT

(Cap. 27:11)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTIONS
5 AND 6 OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICES (REMUNERA-
TION OF HOLDERS) ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING
ORDER —

1. (1) This Order may be cited as the Constitutional Offices ^{Citation and}
(Remuneration of Holders) Order 1985. <sub>commence-
ment.</sub>

(2) Clause 2(a) ~~of this Order shall be deemed to have~~
come into operation on ~~1st January, 1985.~~ *is the King's*

(3) Clause 2(b) of this Order shall be deemed to have
come into operation on 1st January, 1984.

2. The Schedule to the Act is hereby amended as ^{Amendment}
follows — <sub>of the Sched-
ule to the
Act.</sub>

(a) by the substitution for the words "\$57,600" of
the words "\$72,000", for the words "\$52,800",
"\$48,000" and "\$42,000", wherever they occur,
of the words "\$66,000", "\$60,000" and "\$54,000"
respectively;

(b) in the second proviso, by the substitution for
the words "of \$4,800 per annum" of the words
"annually equivalent to the difference between
the salary payable annually to the Chancellor
and that payable annually to the Chief Justice".
