THE LOCAL DEMOCRATIC ORGANS ACT 1980

(Act No. 12 of 1980)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTIONS 9 AND 50 OF THE LOCAL DEMOCRATIC ORGANS ACT 1980, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:—

Citation and commencement.

1. This Order, which amends the Local Democratic Organs (Emoluments of Office-holders) (No. 2) Order 1981\*, may be cited as the Local Democratic Organs (Emoluments of Office-holders) (No. 2) (Amendment) Order 1985 and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1st January, 1984.

Amendment of the Principal Order.

2. The Principal Order is hereby amended by the deletion of clause 3 and the substitution of the following clause therefor —

“Emoluments of chairman and vice-chairman of National Congress of Local Democratic Organs. 3. (1) The chairman of the National Congress of Local Democratic Organs shall be paid each month a salary of two thousand six hundred dollars, a duty allowance of three hundred dollars, an entertainment allowance of three hundred dollars, and a commuted travelling allowance of seven hundred dollars, or in lieu of such travelling allowance, shall be provided with an official car for use on official duties.

(2) The vice-chairman of the National Congress of Local Democratic Organs shall be paid each month a salary of one thousand nine hundred and fifty dollars, a duty allowance of three hundred dollars, an entertainment allowance of three hundred dollars and a commuted travelling allowance of seven hundred dollars, or in lieu of such travelling allowance, shall be provided with an official car for use on official duties.

(3) The chairman of the National Congress of Local Democratic Organs shall be entitled to occupy free of rent a furnished residence provided by the Government, or in lieu thereof, to be paid each month a house allowance of four hundred and fifty dollars.”.
