ORDER

MADE UNDER

THE BRITISH GUIANA (CONSTITUTION) ORDER IN
COUNCIL, 1961.

UNDER SECTION 20(3) OF THE BRITISH GUIANA (CONSTITUTION) ORDER IN COUNCIL, 1961, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS:—

1.(1) This Order may be cited as the British Guiana (Constitution) Citation and commencement.
(Adaptation and Modification of Laws) Order, 1961.

(2) This Order shall come into force on the date on which it is published in the Gazette.

2. The Supreme Court Ordinance is hereby amended

(a) by the repeal of section 7, subsection (1) of section 10, section 11;

(b) by the substitution for the word and figures "section 11" in the proviso to subsection (2) of section 10, of the words and figures "article 87 of the Constitution of British Guiana"; and

(c) by the renumbering of subsection (2) of section 10 as section 10.

Amendment of the Supreme Court Ordinance Chapter 7.

3. Subsection (1) of section 8 of the Criminal Law (Procedure) Ordinance is hereby amended by the substitution for the word "Governor" of the words "Director of Public Prosecutions".

Amendment of section 8(1) of the Criminal Law (Procedure) Ordinance, Chapter 11.

4. Section 4 of the Legal Practitioners Ordinance is hereby amended by the substitution for subsection (3) of the following —

"(3) In this section the expression "Law Officer" means a person called to any Bar aforesaid who holds office as the Attorney General, or on the staff of his Chambers, or as the Director of Public Prosecutions or an officer subordinate to him and acting under and in accordance with his general or special instructions."

Amendment of section 4 of the Legal Practitioners Ordinance, Chapter 30.
