(FACILITIES FOR ENFORCEMENT) ORDINANCE, IN
ACCORDANCE WITH PARAGRAPH 1 OF ARTICLE 22 OF
THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA, AND BY
VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL POWERS ENABLING
HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE
GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Maintenance Orders (Facilities for Enforcement) (Isle of Man) Order, 1961.

2. The Maintenance Orders (Facilities for Enforcement) Ordinance shall extend to maintenance orders made by Courts within the Isle of Man in like manner as it extends to maintenance orders made within England and Ireland.
