ORDER

MADE UNDER

THE DRAINAGE AND IRRIGATION ORDINANCE,  
(Chapter 192).

UNDER SECTION 23(5) OF THE DRAINAGE AND IRRIGATION ORDINANCE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH PARAGRAPH 1 OF ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Drainage and Irrigation (Construction) (No. 7) Order, 1961.
2. The Board shall cause to be constructed the drainage and irrigation works described in the schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

Two greenheart check sluices, one each in the Manchester and Liverpool east sidelines situated approximately 300 and 250 rods respectively south of the Public Road at the junction with the facade drain, within the Lancaster to Manchester Drainage and Irrigation Area.
