

BRITISH GUIANA.

ORDER

MADE UNDER

THE DRAINAGE AND IRRIGATION ORDINANCE,  
(Chapter 192).

UNDER SECTION 11 (1) OF THE DRAINAGE AND IRRIGATION ORDINANCE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH PARAGRAPH (1) OF ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS :—

1. The Drainage and Irrigation Board shall ascertain and determine whether the area, or any part thereof, described in the schedule hereto is suitable for and will be benefited by drainage and irrigation, or drainage or irrigation.
2. The daily newspapers in which this Order is to be published shall be the Daily Chronicle and the Guiana Graphic.

SCHEDULE

That area of land lying between the Somerset and Berks Canal and the Pomeroon River, the boundaries of which shall be as follows:—

Commencing at the junction of the southern bank of the Somerset and Berks Canal with the Atlantic Ocean and proceeding in a south-westerly direction along the aforesaid southern bank of the Somerset and Berks Canal to its junction with the southern bank of the Manikuru Canal; thence in a westerly direction along the aforesaid southern bank of the Manikuru Canal to its junction with the left bank of the Manikuru Creek; thence along the left bank of the Manikuru Creek to its junction with the right bank of the Pomeroon River; thence in a northerly direction along the right bank of the Pomeroon River to its junction with the southern boundary of the tract of land known as Jackson; thence along the southern boundary of the aforesaid tract of land known as Jackson and its prolongation north-easterly to its junction with the Atlantic Ocean; thence in a south-easterly direction along the Atlantic Ocean to the point of commencement.
