ORDER

Made Under  
THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE,  
(Chapter 309).

UNDER SECTION 8 OF THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH PARAGRAPH (1) OF ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Customs Duties (Amendment) Order, 1962.

2. The second proviso to the Trade Classification List and Tariff of Part I of the first schedule to the Customs Ordinance, as amended from time to time, is hereby further amended by the addition of the following new item :

	Preferential Tariff	General Tariff
(15) Linseed oil and polyvinyl acetate when imported for use in the manufacture of paints in a paint factory, provided that the Comptroller is satisfied that they will be used solely for that purpose.	Free	10%
