ORDER

Made Under

THE PUBLIC HEALTH ORDINANCE,  
(Chapter 145).

WHEREAS it has been reported to the Central Board of Health that cases of food poisoning have occurred in certain districts in the County of Essequibo including the Island of Wakenaam;

AND WHEREAS it appears to the Central Board of Health expedient that urgent measures should be taken for the preservation of the public health in the said districts;

NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of the powers conferred by paragraph (e) of section 6 of the Public Health Ordinance, the Central Board of Health hereby orders that no Wheaten Flour or any article of food made from Wheaten Flour shall, from the coming into operation of this order, be transported to or removed from or taken out of the areas lying between Supenaam Creek and Charity in the County of Essequibo and the Island of Wakenaam by any person on any ship or vessel, boat or other sailing craft or by any other means whatsoever.

AND be it known that any person who contravenes the provisions of this Order shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable to a penalty as prescribed under the said Ordinance.
