## BRITISH GUIANA

**CONTROL OF PRICES (AMENDMENT No. 1) ORDER, 1962.**

ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 44 OF THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS 1939 TO CONTROL THE PRICES AT WHICH CERTAIN ARTICLES SHALL BE SOLD.

1. This Order may be cited as the Control of Prices (Amendment No. 1) Order, 1962 and shall be construed and read with the Control of Prices Order 1962 (published in the Gazette of 19th February, 1962) hereinafter referred to as the Principal Order.

2. The Principal Order is hereby amended by the addition of the following items to the First Schedule :—

(1) Maximum retail percentage in North West District—As in Column IV, plus 10 per cent. on all items in this List.”

4. By the addition of Note (3) to the First Schedule —

Plus  $\frac{1}{2}$ c. per lb. on the maximum retail price of Item 2 First Schedule —Sugar—Dark crystals in Column V, when sold in the islands of Leguan, Wakenaam and Fort Island, the village district of Bartica and the Essequibo Coast, including the Pomeroon River.

5. This Order shall come into effect on the 23rd day of February, 1962.

6. Notice of the effect of this Order shall be given by publication of a copy thereof in the Gazette.
