

BRITISH GUIANA.

ORDER

Made Under

**SECTION 44(1) OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH ORDINANCE,
Chapter 145.**

WHEREAS it has become expedient forthwith to prevent the taking out or removal of Milk from the area described in the Schedule hereunder, by reason of the occurrence of bovine Anthrax in the said area;

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of the powers vested in me by sub-section one of section 44 of the Public Health Ordinance, Chapter 145, I do hereby order that no Milk shall be taken out of or removed from this area.

SCHEDULE

That area which is the southern portion of Pln. Toevlugt owned by Mr. Arjoon Rupi and situated on the West Bank of the Demerara River bounded on the north by the "B" line Polder irrigation canal, on the east by the public road, on the south by the boundary with Pln. La Retraite and on the west by the boundary with Pln. Middlesex.
