THE PUBLIC OFFICERS (INSURANCE) ORDINANCE,  
(Chapter 71).

UNDER SECTION 10 (1) OF THE PUBLIC OFFICERS (INSURANCE) ORDINANCE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH PARAGRAPH (1) OF ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Gittens (Transfer of Insurance Policy) Order, 1962.

2. It is hereby declared that the above Ordinance shall cease to apply to the policies of insurance in the sum of one thousand five hundred dollars and five hundred dollars effected on the life of Luis Earl Duncan Gittens with the Barbados Mutual Life Assurance Society Ltd. and the Demerara Mutual Life Assurance Society Ltd. respectively under the said Ordinance in favour of the Financial Secretary, and the Minister of Finance is hereby directed to transfer the said policies of insurance to the said Luis Earl Duncan Gittens and his wife Mary Victoria Gittens and to pay over to them the proceeds of such policies of insurance and any increase thereon.
