THE GEORGETOWN TOWN COUNCIL (SPECIAL POWERS) (WATER SUPPLY) ORDINANCE, 1954, (No. 7 of 1954).

UNDER SECTION 2(2) OF THE GEORGETOWN TOWN COUNCIL (SPECIAL POWERS) (WATER SUPPLY) ORDINANCE, 1954, IN ACCORDANCE WITH PARAGRAPH (1) OF ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS:—

The schedule to the Georgetown Town Council (Special Powers) (Water Supply) Ordinance, 1954, is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the following new area —

- ‘ (i) “Rahaman’s Park” also known as Lot D of Plantation Houston, situate on the right bank of the Demerara River and bounded on the north and east by the East Bank Public Road, on the south by the remainder of Plantation Houston and on the west by the eastern edge of a reserved strip of land 10.29 feet in width to the east of Meadow Bank Village, and immediately east of a trench under the control of the Meadow Bank Country Authority.’
