THE ANIMALS DISEASES ORDINANCE,

(Chapter 258).

UNDER SECTION 15 OF THE ANIMALS DISEASES ORDINANCE, SECTION 20 OF THE BRITISH GUIANA (CONSTITUTION) ORDER IN COUNCIL 1961 AND IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Animals Diseases (Equine Encephalomyelitis) Order, 1962.

2. Owing to the presence in the area described in the Schedule to this Order of cases of equine encephalomyelitis and the necessity for preventing the spread of such disease, the area aforesaid is hereby declared to be, for the purposes of the Animals Diseases Ordinance, an area infected with equine encephalomyelitis.

SCHEDULE

The triangular area bounded by the Atlantic Ocean on the north, on the east by the Corentyne river up to a point opposite Crabwood Creek and on the south by a line drawn between Crabwood Creek and New Amsterdam.
