

BRITISH GUIANA

ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 44 OF THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS 1939 TO CONTROL THE PRICES AT WHICH CERTAIN ARTICLES SHALL BE SOLD.

1. This Order may be cited as the Control of Prices (Amendment No. 7) Order, 1962 and shall be construed and read with the Control of Prices Order 1962 (published in the Gazette of 19th February, 1962) hereinafter referred to as the Principal Order.

2. The Principal Order is hereby amended by the deletion of item 4 "Rice" of the First Schedule and the substitution therefor of the following:
