THE PUBLIC OFFICERS (INSURANCE) ORDINANCE
Chapter 71

UNDER SECTION 10(1) OF THE PUBLIC OFFICERS (INSURANCE) ORDINANCE IN ACCORDANCE WITH PARAGRAPH (1) OF ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS :—

1. This Order may be cited as the D'Ornellas (Transfer of Insurance Policy) Order 1962.

2. It is hereby declared that the Public Officers (Insurance) Ordinance, Chapter 71 shall cease to apply to the policies of insurance in the sum of three thousand, nine hundred and eighteen dollars effected on the life of Claude Frederick D'Ornellas with the Demerara Mutual Life Assurance Society Limited under the said Ordinance in favour of the Financial Secretary, and the Minister of Finance is hereby directed to transfer the said policies of insurance to the said Claude Frederick D'Ornellas and his wife, Mary Angela D'Ornellas and to pay over to them the proceeds of such policies of insurance and any increase thereon.
