THE LAND REGISTRY ORDINANCE, 1959,

(No. 18 of 1959).

UNDER SUBSECTION (1) OF SECTION 17 OF THE LAND REGISTRY ORDINANCE, 1959, IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Land Registry (Registration Area) (Buxton and Friendship) Order, 1962.
2. The area of land defined in the schedule to this Order shall be a registration area.

SCHEDULE

Plantations Buxton and Friendship situate on the East Sea Coast of Demerara and bounded as follows—

On the north by the Atlantic Ocean;

On the east by the common boundary between Plantations Friendship and Vigilance and Crown lands held under Licence No. 99 by the proprietors of Vigilance;

On the south by lands held under Grant No. 4592 by the Village Council of Buxton and Friendship;

On the west by the common boundary between Plantations Buxton and La Reconnaissance and Crown lands held under Licence No. 2754 by the proprietors of Lusignan **cum annexis**.
