ORDER

MADE UNDER

THE PUBLIC OFFICERS (INSURANCE) ORDINANCE,
(Chapter 71).

UNDER SUBSECTION (1) OF SECTION 10 OF THE PUBLIC OFFICERS (INSURANCE) ORDINANCE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Walker (Transfer of Insurance Policy) Order, 1964.

2. It is hereby declared that the Public Officers (Insurance) Ordinance shall cease to apply to the policy of insurance in the sum of seven hundred and twenty dollars, effected on the life of GEORGE HARTMAN FERGUSON WALKER with the Barbados Mutual Life Assurance Society, Limited, under the said Ordinance in favour of the Financial Secretary, and the Minister of Finance is hereby directed to transfer the said policy of insurance to the said GEORGE HARTMAN FERGUSON WALKER and his wife LUCY EUPHRASA WALKER and to pay over to them the proceeds of such policy of insurance and any increase thereon.
