

## THE MARITIME BOUNDARIES ACT 1977

(No. 10 of 1977)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON THE MINISTER BY SECTION 25(1) OF THE MARITIME BOUNDARIES ACT, 1977, THE FOLLOWING ORDER IS HEREBY MADE:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Fishing Boats (Republic of Cuba) Designation Order 1978, and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1st November, 1978.
- 2. The Republic of Cuba is hereby designated for the purposes of section 25(1).
- 3. (1) The area in which a fishing boat registered in the Republic of Cuba may fish in the fishery zone shall be that extending shorewards to the 19 fathoms isobath.
- (2) The description of fish for which any such fishing boat may fish is shrimp of the species: Penaeus duorarum notialis (pink shrimp), Penaeus aztecus subtilis (brown shrimp), Penaeus braziliensis (spotted pink shrimp or hopper), and Penaeus schmitti (white shrimp).
