BY SECTION 5 OF THE TRADE ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE
FOLLOWING ORDER:—

1. This Order, which amends the Trade (Control of ^{Citation} Prices) Order*, may be cited as the Trade (Control of Prices) (Amendment) (No. 6) Order 1979.
