THE ACQUISITION OF LANDS FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES ACT

(Chapter 62:05)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTIONS 3 AND 4 OF THE ACQUISITION OF LANDS FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER —

1. This Order may be cited as the Acquisition of Lands for Public purposes (Upper Demerara Forestry Project, Port Site) Order 1979.
2. The proposed construction of a Port Site on the land described in the schedule hereunder is hereby declared to be a public work.
3. The Chief Works Officer together with his agents, servants or workmen is hereby authorised to enter upon the said land for the purpose of surveying or otherwise examining such land with a view to the acquisition of the whole or part of such land for the construction of the public work aforesaid.

SCHEDULE

A Block of land measuring 2,300 feet by 1,000 feet comprising portions of Lots 16, 17, 18 and 19 Plantation Charters or Suyd Beveland situate approximately 55 miles up the Demerara River on its left bank, in the county of Demerara, Guyana and bounded as follows:

- On the North:** By the northern boundary of Lot 19 Charters.
- On the East:** By the Demerara River.
- On the South:** By an imaginary line 147 feet south of and parallel to the northern boundary of Lot 16 Charters. ...
- On the West:** By an imaginary line 1,000 feet west and generally parallel to Mean High Water Mark of the Demerara River at Charters.

The aforesaid Block of land is shown on a compiled plan prepared by the Survey Division of the Ministry of Works and Transport (Works), Kingston, Georgetown, on record as Drawing No. DE 188 dated 6th March, 1979.
