THE TRADE ORDINANCE, 1958  
(No. 34 of 1958)

UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE TRADE ORDINANCE, 1958, IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Trade (Control of Imports and Exports) (No. 3) Order, 1964, and shall be construed and read as one with the Trade (Control of Import and Export) (No. 2) Order, 1963\*, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Order, and any Order amending the same.

2. The first schedule to the Principal Order is hereby amended by the insertion below the word "Soap" in item 552-02 of the following —

"Cleansing preparations without soap (detergents)".
