THE ACQUISITION OF LANDS FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES ACT

(Cap. 62:05)

- IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTIONS 3 AND 4 OF THE ACQUISITION OF LANDS FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:—
- 1. This Order may be cited as the Acquisition of Lands for Public Purposes (Regional Hospital, Berbice) Order 1979.
- 2. The proposed construction of a Regional Hospital on the land described in the Schedule hereunder is hereby declared to be a public work.
- 3. The Chief Works Officer, together with his agents, servants or workmen, is hereby authorised to enter upon the said land for the purpose of surveying or otherwise examining such land with a view to the acquisition of the whole or part of it for the public work aforesaid.

SCHEDULE

That portion of land containing approximately 22 acres being part of Block "C" situate in the Sheet Anchor/Cumberland Local Government District, on the right bank of the Canje River on the East Sea Coast in the County of Berbice, Guyana, and bounded as follows:

On the North: By the southern boundary of the Reserve between Ordnance Fort Lands and Sheet Anchor or Lot No. 1.

On the East: By the western boundary of the Reserve between Sheet Anchor or Lot No. 1 and Cumberland or Lot No. 2.

On the South: By the southern boundary of Lots 5B, 4B, 3B, 2A and 1A.

On the West: By the eastern boundary of the Old Fort Road and the common boundary between Lots 3B and 2B.

The aforesaid land is shown bordered blue on a plan prepared by the Survey Division of the Ministry of Works and Transport (Works), Kingston, Georgetown, and on record in that Division as Drawing No. CB 148 dated 19th June, 1978.

Block "C" referred to above, is shown on:

- (a) a plan by D. M. Edghill and J. L. Yhap, Sworn Land Surveyors, dated 1st September, 1947, on record at the Department of Lands and Surveys as Plan No. 5531; and
- (b) a plan by Harnandan Singh, Sworn Land Surveyor, dated 1st June, 1961, on record at the Department of Lands and Surveys as Plan No. 9891.
