IN EXERCISE OF THE POWER CONFERRED UPON THE MINISTER
BY SECTION 15 OF THE ANIMALS DISEASES ACT, I HEREBY
ORDER AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Animals Diseases (An- Citation.
thrax) Order 1977.

2. Owing to the presence in the area described in the Sche- ^{Infected}
dule of cases of anthrax and the necessity for preventing the ^{area.}
spread of such diseases, the said area is hereby declared for ^{Schedule}
the purposes of the Act to be an area infected with anthrax.

SCHEDULE

The area is on the Left Bank of the Mahaica River, the tract com-
mences, on the Northern Boundary of Mary's Hope, about one (1) mile
south of the Georgetown-Rosignol Public Road, and its boundaries extend
along the Northern Boundary of the said Mary's Hope to the New Shank's
Canal thence southwards along the New Shank's Canal to its junction
with the East Demerara Water Conservancy Canal, thence eastwards along
the East Demerara Water Conservancy Canal to the FLAGSTAFF, thence
southwards along the East Demerara Water Conservancy Canal to a point
where the prolongation of the Southern Boundary of Lot No. 5 or
HUNTLEY cuts the said East Demerara Water Conservancy Canal, thence
along the said Southern Boundary of Lot No. 5 or HUNTLEY, to the Left
Bank of the Mahaica River, thence downwards along the Left Bank of
the Mahaica River to the point of commencement.
