MADE UNDER
THE TRADE ACT
(Chapter 91:01)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWER CONFERRED UPON THE MINISTER BY SECTION 5 OF THE TRADE ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:—

1. This Order which amends the Trade (Control of Prices) Order^{* Citation.} may be cited as the Trade (Control of Prices) (Amendment) (No. 48) Order 1977.

2. The Principal Order is hereby amended —
