ORDER
Made Under

THE EMERGENCY POWERS REGULATIONS, 1963.
(No. 7 of 1963)

WHEREAS it is necessary for maintaining supplies and services essential to the life of the community that certain property other than land situated in British Guiana be requisitioned:

NOW THEREFORE acting in accordance with article 22 of the Constitution of British Guiana and under regulation 36 of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 1963, and by virtue and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, it is hereby ordered by the Governor as follows:-

1. This Order may be cited as the Emergency Powers (Requisition of Gasolene) (No. 2) Order, 1963.

2. (1) In this Order "Competent Authority" means the Minister of Works and Hydraulics and includes any person authorised in writing by him to perform any of his functions under this Order. Any person so authorised shall act subject to such directions as may from time to time be given by the Competent Authority.

(2) The General Manager of the Transport and Harbours Department for the time being shall be deemed to have been authorised for the purposes of the preceding paragraph to perform all the functions of the Competent Authority under this Order.

(3) In this Order "Company" means the Esso Standard Oil S.A. Limited whose address for service is at 106 New Garden Street, Georgetown and who carries on business at Main and Bentick Streets, Georgetown.

3. (1) 800 gallons of gasolene from the stocks of the Company situated at Atkinson on the East Bank of the Demerara River are hereby requisitioned.

(2) The provisions of this article shall have effect subject to the provisions for payment of compensation contained in regulation 37 of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 1963.

4. The Competent Authority may perform all such functions as be necessary or expedient in connection with the requisitioning.
5. This Order shall come into force on the 28th day of May,
