ORDER

MADE UNDER

THE LAND REGISTRY ORDINANCE, 1959,
(No. 18 of 1959).

UNDER SUBSECTION (1) OF SECTION 17 OF THE LAND REGISTRY ORDINANCE, 1959, IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Land Registry (Registration Area) (Bush Lot) Order, 1963.
2. The area of land defined in the schedule to this Order shall be a registration area.

SCHEDULE

That area of land being the first depth of Plantation Bush Lot also called Lot 27 situate on the Corentyne Coast in the County of Berbice and bounded as follows —

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| On the north : | By the Atlantic Ocean. |
| On the south : | By the second depth of Plantation Bush Lot or No. 27 held under Licence of Occupancy No. A2610. |
| On the east : | By the Government Ketting. |
| On the west : | By the Government Ketting. |

and containing an area of 530.10 English Acres (500 Rhymland Acres) as shown on a plan by J. A. P. Bowhill (Sworn Land Surveyor) dated 16th February, 1918, and recorded in the Department of Lands and Mines as plan No. 2600.
