ORDER

MADE UNDER

THE LAND REGISTRY ORDINANCE, 1959,

(No. 18 of 1959).

UNDER SUBSECTION (1) OF SECTION 17 OF THE LAND REGISTRY ORDINANCE, 1959, IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Land Registry (Registration Area) (Good Hope) Order, 1963.

2. The area of land defined in the schedule to this Order shall be a registration area.

SCHEDULE

Plantation Good Hope situate on the left bank of the Essequibo River in the County of Essequibo, bounded on the north by Plantation Spring Garden, on the east by the Essequibo River, on the south by the Supenaam River and on the west by Crown lands.
