ORDER

MADE UNDER

THE ELECTORAL PROVISIONS (REGISTRATION) ORDINANCE, 1961,
(No. 10 of 1961)

UNDER SECTION 10 OF THE ELECTORAL PROVISIONS (REGISTRATION) ORDINANCE, 1961, IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Electoral Provisions (Registration) (No. 2) Order, 1963.

2. The 1st September, 1963, is hereby appointed as the day with reference to which the register of every electoral district compiled under the Electoral Provisions (Registration) Ordinance, 1961, shall be revised in accordance with Parts II and III of the first schedule to the said Ordinance.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This Order appoints the day with reference to which the register of every electoral district compiled under the Electoral Provisions (Registration) Ordinance, 1961, shall be revised for the year 1963.

Persons entitled to be registered as electors in the revised register shall be the persons qualified in that behalf on that day.
