ORDER

MADE UNDER

THE ELECTRICITY ORDINANCE, 1957,
(No. 34 of 1957).

UNDER SECTIONS 14 AND 21 OF THE ELECTRICITY ORDINANCE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Electricity (Extension of Areas of Supply) Order, 1963.

2. The first schedule to the Electricity Ordinance, 1957, is hereby amended —

(a) by numbering the contents of that schedule as paragraph (1) by the insertion of the symbol “(1)” before the word “The”;

(b) by the addition of the following paragraph as paragraph (2) :—

“(2) The areas outside the limits of the areas prescribed in paragraph (1) of this schedule up to a distance of fifteen miles beyond those limits.”

3. The second schedule to the Electricity Ordinance, 1957, is hereby amended —

(a) by numbering the contents of that schedule as paragraph (1) by the insertion of the symbol “(1)” before the word “Within”; and

(b) by the addition of the following paragraph as paragraph (2):—

<p>“(2) Within the areas prescribed in paragraph (2) of the first schedule to this Ordinance.</p>	<p>The rates approved by the Governor in accordance with section 21 of this Ordinance and published in the Gazette on the 14th September, 1963.”</p>
