

BRITISH GUIANA

ORDER

MADE UNDER

THE TRADE ORDINANCE, 1958.

(No. 34 of 1958).

UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE TRADE ORDINANCE, 1958, IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Trade (Control of Prices) (Amendment) (No. 4) Order, 1963, and shall be construed and read with the Trade (Control of Prices) Order, 1963*, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Order, and any Order amending the same.

2. Article 2 of the Principal Order is hereby amended —

- (a) by the deletion of the letter and brackets “(d)” appearing immediately before the expression “deodorised coconut oil”;
- (b) by the insertion after the definition of the expression “actual cost” of the following definition —

“distributor’s price” means the maximum price at which any person who has purchased any refined coconut oil from a manufacturer in British Guiana of that oil or who has imported into British Guiana any refined coconut oil or refined soya bean oil may sell that oil to a wholesaler; and

- (c) by the substitution for the expression “deodorised coconut oil” of the expression “refined coconut oil”.

3. Paragraphs (a) and (b) of item No. 1 in the first schedule to the Principal Order is hereby amended —

- (a) by the deletion of the word “Deodorised” wherever it occurs therein; and
- (b) by the substitution for the expression “Competent Authority’s Price” wherever it occurs therein of the expression “Distributor’s Price”.

4. This Order shall come into force on the first day of January, 1964.
