

## BRITISH GUIANA

## ORDER

## MADE UNDER

## THE INTERPRETATION ORDINANCE,

(Chapter 5).

UNDER SECTION 40 OF THE INTERPRETATION ORDINANCE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Delegation of Powers Order, 1965.
2. The Minister for the time being charged with the responsibility for Local Government is hereby deputed to exercise on behalf of the Governor the powers specified in the first column of the schedule to this Order and conferred on the Governor by the provisions of the Ordinances specified in the second column of the said schedule, subject, however, to the following conditions and qualifications—
  - (a) that the delegation of the powers effected by this Order shall remain in force until it is varied or revoked by the Governor;
  - (b) that the exercise of any power delegated by this Order shall be subject to any directions, either general or particular, which the Governor may from time to time give in that respect.

## SCHEDULE

Powers Delegated	Ordinance
1. To appoint persons to be Georgetown Sewerage and Water Commissioners.	Georgetown Sewerage and Water Ordinance, Chapter 153, Section 9(1) (a) as amended by Ordinance No. 19 of 1957.
2. To revoke the appointment of an appointed Commissioner.	Georgetown Sewerage and Water Ordinance, Chapter 153, section 9(7) as amended by Ordinance No. 19 of 1957.
3. To determine the sufficiency of any excuse given by a Commissioner for failure to attend meetings of Commissioners.	Georgetown Sewerage and Water Ordinance, Chapter 153, Section 9 (8) (c).
4. To appoint any person to be a Commissioner in the case of death or vacancy in the office of a Commissioner.	Georgetown Sewerage and Water Ordinance, Chapter 153, Section 9(9).
5. To appoint a number of persons not exceeding three to serve on the Mayor and Town Council of Georgetown.	Municipal Councils (Postponement of Elections) Ordinance, 1958, (No. 32 of 1958), Section 5.
6. To appoint a number of persons not exceeding three to serve on the Mayor and Town Council of New Amsterdam.	Municipal Councils (Postponement of Elections) Ordinance, 1958, (No. 32 of 1958), Sections 5 and 8.
