THE INTERPRETATION ORDINANCE,

(Chapter 5)

UNDER SECTION 40 OF THE INTERPRETATION ORDINANCE AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING ME IN THAT BEHALF, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Delegation of Powers (No. 3) Order, 1965.

2. The Minister of Labour and Social Security is hereby deputed to exercise on behalf of the Governor the power specified in the first Column of the schedule to this Order conferred on the Governor by the Ordinance mentioned in the second column of the said schedule, subject however to the following conditions and qualifications—

- (a) that the delegation of the power effected by this Order shall remain in force until it is varied or revoked by the Governor.;
- (b) that the exercise of any power delegated by this Order shall be subject to any directions, either general or particular, which the Governor may from time to time give in that respect.

SCHEDULE
