ORDER

MADE UNDER

THE EXCHANGE CONTROL ORDINANCE, 1958,
(No. 28 of 1958).

UNDER SECTION 4 (1) OF THE EXCHANGE CONTROL ORDINANCE, 1958, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Exchange Control (Specified Currency) (Amendment) Order, 1965, and shall be construed and read as one with the Exchange Control (Specified Currency) Order, 1959*, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Order, and any Order amending the same.

2. The schedule to the Principal Order is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the following —

“Japanese Yen
Spanish Pesetas”.
