ORDER

MADE UNDER

THE PUBLIC OFFICERS (INSURANCE) ORDINANCE
(Chapter 71)

UNDER SUBSECTION (1) OF SECTION 10 OF THE PUBLIC OFFICERS (INSURANCE) ORDINANCE AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR'S DEPUTY AS FOLLOWS :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Cumberbatch (Transfer of Insurance Policy) Order, 1965.

2. It is hereby declared that the Public Officers (Insurance) Ordinance shall cease to apply to the policy of insurance in the sum of five hundred dollars effected on the life of EDWIN WALTER CUMBERBATCH with the Barbados Mutual Life Assurance Society under the said Ordinance in favour of the Financial Secretary, and the Minister of Finance is hereby directed to transfer the said policy of insurance to the said EDWIN WALTER CUMBERBATCH and his wife CATHERINE CUMBERBATCH and pay over to them the proceeds of such policy of insurance and any increase thereon.
