

BRITISH GUIANA**ORDER**

MADE UNDER

THE LAND REGISTRY ORDINANCE, 1959,

(No. 18 of 1959).

UNDER SECTION 17(1) AND (2) OF THE LAND REGISTRY ORDINANCE, 1959, IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Land Registry (Registration Area) (Demerara River) (No. 2) Order, 1965.

2. The area of land defined in the schedule to this Order is hereby designated a registration area.

3. The fee payable in respect of the first registration of any land in the area defined in the schedule to this Order shall be five dollars.

SCHEDULE

An area of land on the right bank of the Demerara River bounded as follows:—

On the north	by the southern boundary of Atkinson Field
On the south	by the southern boundary of Lot No. 42 or Amelia's Ward
On the east	by Crown land
On the west	by the right bank of the Demerara River

and comprising the following Plantations — Lot No. 42 or Amelia's Ward, Lot No. 41 or Fitz Hope, Dalgin or Lot No. 40, Adventure, Lot No. 38, Lot No. 37, Elizabeth, York, Loo Lands, Dora, Loo Lands, Uitspa, Vryheid, Warida, Endeavour, Jalousie, Susannah's Rust, Teddington, Low Wood or Hauraruni, San Souci, Elizabeth Ann, Uit, New St. Eustatius, Lana and Alliance.
