ORDER

MADE UNDER

THE SEA DEFENCE ORDINANCE

(Chapter 191)

UNDER SECTION 11 OF THE SEA DEFENCE ORDINANCE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Sea Defence (Emergency) Order, 1965.
2. The Sea Defence Board is hereby ordered to take such immediate action and perform such works as may in the opinion of the Board be necessary to avert or mitigate inundation by the sea of the land at Plantation Amsterdam bounded on the east by Plantation Cane-field and on the west by Plantation Endeavour situated on the Island of Leguan in the Sea Defence District No. 3.
