- he is a permanent employee of the Government of that country and is not engaged in any private occupation for gain within British Guiana;
- his appointment as a consular officer or consular employee of the consulate has been duly notified to the Government of British Guiana; and

- (ii) he he is a permanent employee of the Government of any such country in the Commonwealth or of the Republic of Ireland and is not engaged in any private occupation for gain within British Guiana;
- (iii) his appointment as such representative or as a member of the official staff of such representative Guiana; and has been duly notified to the Government of British

(jv) any goods imported by him shall be for his personal use or the personal use of members of his family forming part of his household."
