ORDER

MADE UNDER

THE BOERASIRIE CREEK ORDINANCE  
(CHAPTER 275)

UNDER SECTION 19(1) (b) OF THE BOERASIRIE CREEK ORDINANCE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR'S DEPUTY AS FOLLOWS:—

Plantation Good Hope *cum annexis* situated on the East Bank, Essequibo River, the boundaries of which are described in the schedule hereto shall be deemed to be included in the schedule to the Boerasirie Creek Ordinance and to contain an area of 200 English acres.

SCHEDULE

That triangular piece of land adjoining the Boerasirie Conservancy dam in the rear of Plantations Good Hope, Ruby, Farm and Le Destin, situated on the East Bank of the Essequibo River, and commencing at the junction of the prolongation in a southerly direction of the common boundary between Plantations Greenwich Park and Good Hope with the Boerasirie Conservancy dam aforesaid, and extending thence in a westerly direction along the Boerasirie Conservancy dam to its junction with the Kent Dam thence in a north-easterly direction along the said Kent Dam to its junction with the prolongation of the common boundary between Plantations Greenwich Park and Good Hope, thence in a southerly direction along the prolongation of the common boundary between Plantations Greenwich Park and Good Hope to the point of commencement.
