

BRITISH GUIANA

ORDER

MADE UNDER

ARTICLE 21 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA

WHEREAS it is provided by paragraph (1) of article 21 of the Constitution of British Guiana that the Governor acting with the concurrence of the Premier may, from time to time by order published in the Gazette, prescribe the offices that are to constitute the personal staff of the Governor, the salaries and allowances that are to be paid to the members of the personal staff of the Governor, and the other sums that are to be paid in respect of the expenditure attaching to the office of Governor;

AND WHEREAS on the 15th day of July, 1961, the Governor acting in pursuance of the provisions of subsection (1) of section 4 of the British Guiana (Constitution) Order in Council, 1961, made an order prescribing the offices that are to constitute the personal staff of the Governor and the salaries and allowances that are to be paid to the members of the personal staff of the Governor, and the other sums that are to be paid in respect of the expenditure attaching to the office of Governor;

AND WHEREAS it is provided by paragraph (9) of article 115 of the Constitution of British Guiana that where any power is conferred by the said Constitution to make any proclamation, order, rules or regulations or to give any directions, the power shall be construed as including a power exercisable in like manner to amend or revoke any such proclamation, order, rules, regulations or directions;

NOW THEREFORE I, acting in pursuance of the aforesaid provisions of the Constitution of British Guiana, and by virtue and in exercise of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, and with the concurrence of the Premier, do hereby amend Part I of the schedule to the said order in the following respects —

- (a) by the insertion of "\$800" in the third column thereof with reference to the item "Domestic Staff (10)"; and
- (b) by the addition thereto of the office of "Clerical Assistant" in the first column thereof, and of the following "Appropriate salary for the individual officer calculated in accordance with the Salary Scale A 34 for the time being in force in the Public Service." in the second column thereof with reference to that office.
