## THE TRADE ACT (Cap. 91:01)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 5 OF THE TRADE ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:-

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Control of Prices Citation. (Liquefied Petroleum Gas) Order 1978.
- 2. In this Order Liquefied Petroleum Gas is commonly Interprecalled Cooking Gas.
- 3. The maximum prices at which the goods, cooking gas, Maximum mentioned in the first column of the Schedule shall be sold by Retail retail, in the areas mentioned in the second, third, fourth and fifth columns respectively of the said Schedule shall be the schedule. price specified respectively in such columns.

For the purposes of this Order Guyana shall be divided Guyana into four areas -

divided into

- (a) City of Georgetown, and those areas along the East Coast and East Bank, respectively, of the County of Demerara;
- Town of New Amsterdam to Crab-wood Creek in the (b) County of Berbice;
- (c) West Coast Berbice in the County of Berbice and West Demerara and the town of Linden in the County of Demerara:
- (d) Elsewhere (areas not covered in (a), (b) or (c).
