THE DRAINAGE AND IRRIGATION ACT

(Cap. 64:03)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 13 OF THE DRAINAGE AND IRRIGATION ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Drainage and Irrigation (Prescription of Proportion of Capital Costs) Order 1978.
2. No proprietor of any estate within the area described in the Schedule shall bear any proportion of the capital costs of the proposed works to be carried out by the Drainage and Irrigation Board within that area.

SCHEDULE

That area of land situate between Plantation Johanna Cecelia and the Supenaam River on the Essequibo Coast and bounded as follows:—

- On the North:** by the common boundary between Plantation Johanna Cecelia and Plantation Maria's Lodge from the back boundary of Plantation Maria's Lodge to the mean high water mark of the Atlantic Ocean.
- On the South:** by the left bank of the Supenaam River commencing from the mouth of the said Supenaam River thence along the said left bank of the Supenaam River to the point of intersection made by the left bank of the Tapakuma Creek and the left bank of the Supenaam River.

ON the East:

by the line marking the mean high water mark of the Atlantic Ocean commencing from the common boundary between Plantation Johanna Cecelia and Plantation Maria's Lodge and extending in a southerly direction along the aforesaid mean high water mark of the Atlantic Ocean to the mouth of the Supenaam River.

ON the West:

by the back boundaries of Plantations Maria's Lodge, Belfield, Suddie, Ondernteming, Adventure, Airy Hall Riverstown, Pomona, Huis T'D'ieren, Middlesex, Vilvoorden, Fairfield, Hibernia, Three Friends and Dry Shore, Warousi, Makeshift, Aurora, Good Intent, Spring Garden and Good Hope, and the prolongation of the back boundary of Plantation Good Hope for approximately 6,000 feet to its intersection with the left bank of the Tapakuma Creek, thence along the left bank of the Tapakuma Creek to its point of intersection with the left bank of the Supenaam River, together with the conservancy formed by the Ituribisi River, the Ikuraka River, the Ikuraka Lake, Mashabo Creek, Matara Creek, Kumakai Creek, Kariakwa Creek and Kamen Creek.
