THE POLICE ACT

(Cap. 16:01)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWER CONFERRED UPON THE MINISTER
BY SECTION 93 OF THE POLICE ACT, I HEREBY ORDER AS
FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as **the Rural Constables (Fees and Allowances) Order, 1978** and shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st November, 1978. Citation.

2. Whenever any rural constable is called out or employed on full time service with the Police Force or whenever he serves or executes any process mentioned in Section 90 of the Act, he shall, instead of being paid at the rates specified in such items of the Schedule to the Act as are referred to in the first column of the Schedule to this Order, be paid at the rates specified in the second column of the last mentioned Schedule opposite such references, respectively. Fees payable to Rural Constables.
