ORDER**Made Under****THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT****(Cap 51:02)**

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE BY SECTION 48 OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:-

- Citation and commencement. 1. This Order may be cited as the Road Traffic (Railway Embankment Road) (Two-Way) Order 2001 and shall come into operation on the 1st December, 2001.
- Use of road. 2. Subject to clauses 3 and 4, a person shall be permitted to drive a vehicle on the road specified in Column 1 of the Schedule in the direction specified in Column 2 thereof.
- Restriction of goods vehicle, etc. 3. No vehicle being a goods vehicle, including a motor lorry or pickup truck, except where that vehicle belongs to and is driven by a member of the Disciplined Forces, shall proceed in either direction along that portion of the Railway Embankment Road between Enmore Estate Road and Sheriff Street other than for the purpose (the proof whereof shall lie on the driver of the vehicle)-
- (a) of enabling repairs to be effected to the said vehicle or another vehicle or the said portion of public road;
 - (b) for gaining access to or making egress from any premises for the purpose of loading anything on or unloading from any premises situated along the said portion of public road;
 - (c) for gaining access to or making egress from the premises of the owner or that of the driver or person in whose care the vehicle is,

and in every such case the vehicle shall enter and leave such portion of the public road by the shortest route leading to or from each of the above-mentioned places.

Animal drawn vehicle.

- 4. No vehicle drawn by an animal shall during the period commencing at 3 p.m. and ending at 9 a.m. proceed in either direction along that portion of the Railway Embankment Road between Enmore Estate Road and Sheriff Street.
